Job Duties:

Operates various types of trucks and related equipment including tractors, loaders, and dump trucks for the maintenance and repair of roads.

Loads and dumps crushed stone, sand, and salt from trucks, and removes snow from county roads using appropriate equipment.

Regularly checks trucks and equipment to ensure proper fluid levels and mechanical functions.

Patches, chips, and seals roads, digs ditches, scrapes, grades, and maintains road berms and shoulders, including the replacement of ditch tiles and pipes, as needed.

Operates mowers and functions as heavy equipment operator and/or laborer as needed. Performs related duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Must possess a valid CDL license and can legally operate all department vehicles. Knowledge of and ability to operate trucks and related equipment.

Basic knowledge of the mechanics of light and heavy equipment.

Knowledge of safety procedures for working in or around heavy equipment and/or working around traffic.

Ability to perform preventative maintenance and minor repairs.
